Texas Autocross Weekend 2009 Summary

The 9th annual Texas Autocross Weekend was held 25 – 26 July 2009. We had competition teams from University of Texas at Arlington (UTA), University of Texas at Austin (UT), University of Kansas (KU), University of Oklahoma (OU), University of New Mexico (UNM), Missouri Science and Technology (MS&T), Wichita State University (WSU), University of South Florida (USF), and Iowa State University (ISU). In addition, we had three schools attend without cars: Texas A&M University, University of Missouri – Columbia, and South Dakota School of Mines and Technology. Three faculty advisors were there with their teams. There were 119 folks registered to attend.

There were 23 FSAE cars there plus a Bmod, the UTA-inspired F440, and a home-built 2-seater FSAE-style car. There were 58 drivers on the UTA Saturday tracks and 39 drivers for the Sunday autocross.

We had numerous spectators and sponsors join us as well. Just after noon we ran out of the 200 release forms that I printed and I am sure that numerous people didn't even know to sign the form. There were several people taking video and photos of this event. See the publicity links at the end of this report.

Friday Events: Several teams arrived early on Friday for shop tours and last-minute car tuning at the track. About 50 folks attended the Friday night social at my house. Most were challenged with interesting puzzles and games. We watched a lot of FSAE videos and enjoyed snacks and getting to know each other. There were some fine folks there.

Saturday Events: On Saturday, we raced on the big lot at UTA. In the morning we setup the 1998 FSAE Endurance track and in the afternoon we had a more open SCCA-style track. The BBQ lunch (and the Friday social) was sponsored by Arnold Petsche of the A.E. Petsche Company who provides wire and connectors to the aviation industry. Saturday night was a pizza party and demonstration of SolidWorks sponsored by Texas Engineering Systems. Taylor Race, who provides drivetrain components to most of the FSAE teams, and Texas Section of SAE provided drinks and facilities on Saturday.

Sunday Events: On Sunday, we joined the monthly autocross hosted by our local sports car club, Equipe Rapide. Equipe Rapide also provided the timing and scoring for us on Saturday. It rained about 3 hours after the Sunday event and the temperature didn't get into the triple digits either day (that is not to say that it wasn't hot...). We were lucky with the weather.





Saturday Morning Track

The Saturday morning track was the traditional 1998 FSAE Endurance Track that we run every year. This track is the identical size of the track used in 1998 and just barley fits in our parking lot. It is good to run this track every year since it is typical of what a FSAE track should be and has numerous different elements. It is interesting to see how the speeds have increased since 1998 (see history at the end of the report).



As the morning progressed, the fastest times switched from school-to-school, but at the end of the morning, Colin Synder in the 2009 KU car was victorious. Not only that, but Jared Anderson from KU took second place. The next three places were taken by UTA, and MS&T joined these two schools for the top 10. There were some very fast runs made on that track.




Colin Synder from KU wins the morning UTA track

Saturday Afternoon Track

The afternoon track was setup to give everyone some experience and practice for the anticipated higher speeds normally found in an SCCA-style autocross track. As a matter of fact, it was probably too fast and I won't admit to what I thought the top speed was, but you could say that it

"blew the wings" off of one car. This course had some good slaloms, 180's, offset slaloms (what I would call wiggles), a big sweeper, and the famed "walls of death".



Drama played out in the afternoon as well as the top time bounced around. Those cars were just really fast with the winged cars dominating. Eric Leichtle from UTA took the top time with an average speed of 45.8 mph. UTA's long-time successful driver Erick Kohler took second in the UTA F06 250 cc 4-cylinder turbocharged car that revs to 19,000 rpm. That car was the darling of the weekend it appears. One of UTA's new drivers, Josh Hahne took third. Nick Roberts from KU took 4th with MS&T and UNM placing in the top 10.



Sunday's Autocross at Equipe Rapide

Although 58 drivers pre-registered for the autocross, only (did I say only...) 39 drivers were present due to car attrition and teams going home early. Gary Kramar, our chief of timing on Saturday, setup the track for Sunday. It featured slaloms and sweepers on a concrete parking lot and some really fast times were set.



Everyone got four regular runs, but a driver could sign up for two extra runs for a PAX competition for prize money. In the PAX competition, your time was multiplied by some factor so that every class had the opportunity to win. We had four FSAE drivers win money and one of UTA's new drivers won the PAX competition (and FTD) in his Bmod car.

As tires overheated and the day progressed with the usual fast times dropping, Adam Hardin from MS&T won the FSAE class with a time of 28.457. Just 0.271 seconds back was Colin Snyder from KU and 0.164 seconds back from Synder was Alec Surratt also from MS&T. Nick Roberts and Jared Anderson from KU took the next two places and UTA made up the rest of the top 10.
